## Employment Program Spotlight - SNPJ Strabane

The SNPJ Lodge 138 in Strabane PA has been a staple in the community for many years. The Slovene National Benefit Society enjoys a history that stretches back more than a century. Founded on April 6, 1904, SNPJ was initially incorporated as "Slovenska Narodna Podporna Jednota", which translates to "Slovene National Benefit Society" in English. In honor of the founders we have retained our Slovenian initials, and our society is now best known by its original Slovenian acronym, "SNPJ."

As a well-known organization in the local community and knowing some of the staff there personally, it was a perfect fit when the opportunity arose to provide our individuals with job training while also providing the SNPJ with the custodial services they needed. Supernova Employment Specialists and individuals are responsible for the general custodial duties of the Lodge. The individuals perform their duties 7-days per week maintaining the bar area, dining area, catering hall and the bowling alley.

Our team loves working at the SNPJ and regularly hold and attend events there. Just last month, we held an outdoor mixer where staff and individuals were able to interact with each other and learn to play bocce (belina if you ask the employees) and when the weather changes, we will hold a bowling night.

The relationships our individuals are gaining are second only to the confidence in their work skills. This has been a positive partnership for everyone involved and has also opened the door for some of our individuals to want to expand their job duties.

Here are some pictures from this month, thanks to everyone who joins in and makes Walking Club such a fun part of our week!








