Our Cooking Corner baked a creamy and cheesy Potato Leek Soup to warm us up for the holiday season! This class was led by Melissa Hitchman and Michele Grande who helped to create this savory soup, and now you can enjoy it too!

Ingredients/Seasonings:

- 6-8 gold potatoes
- 1 leek stalk
- Bay leaves
- Fresh thyme
- Chicken broth - 2 boxes
- Cheddar cheese
- Heavy cream
- Bacon


Instructions:

1. Peel, chop and place potatoes in large pot.
2. Chop and wash leeks, add to pot - add in 2 bay leaves and fresh thyme
3. Cover ingredients with chicken stock and bring to a boil.
4. Remove most of the potatoes, leaving some chunks and blend until smooth - remember to find and remove the bay leaves
5. Add desired amount of heavy cream and stir
6. Add cheddar cheese and mix until melted
7. Serve, top with bacon and enjoy!
